Growing beans in clear bags Q – How do seeds grow?

Word	Meaning
Roots	Underground part of plant
Stem	Main. Long part of plant – holds it up
Leaf	Usually green and flat to catch light
Petal	Colourful part of flower
Flower	Colourful to attract insects
Shoot	First growth from seed
Trunk	Large upright part of tree
Evergreen	Doesn't drop leaves in winter
Deciduous	Drops leaves in winter
