

Eden Park Primary School Knowledge Organiser



The powerful knowledge we will take away from this Learning Enquiry (what will we be learning)

- Explore natural materials, indoors and outside, e.g. wet sand, water, bark, soil
- Uses the language of size, such as big, little, tiny, small, huge, tall
- Recognise and point to objects if asked about them

The Important skills gained from this learning experience will be:

- Be increasingly able to talk about and manage their emotions.
- Anticipate phrases and actions in rhymes and songs
- Begin to show 'effortful control'. For example, waiting for a turn and resisting the strong impulse to grab what they want or push their way to the front

Maths's focus:

- -Begins to sort various objects into categories such as shape, size, colours
- -Uses the language of size, such as big, little, tiny, small, huge, tall

Literacy Focus:

- -Makes marks on paper to represent objects such as their name or family members e.g. 'that says my name
- -Can name the pictures on the Read Write Inc. frieze frame cards e.g. mountain, apple
