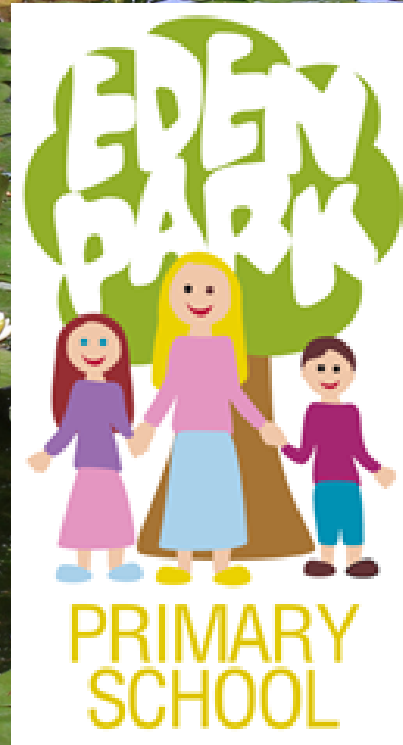

**12:15pm-12:30pm** Book time.

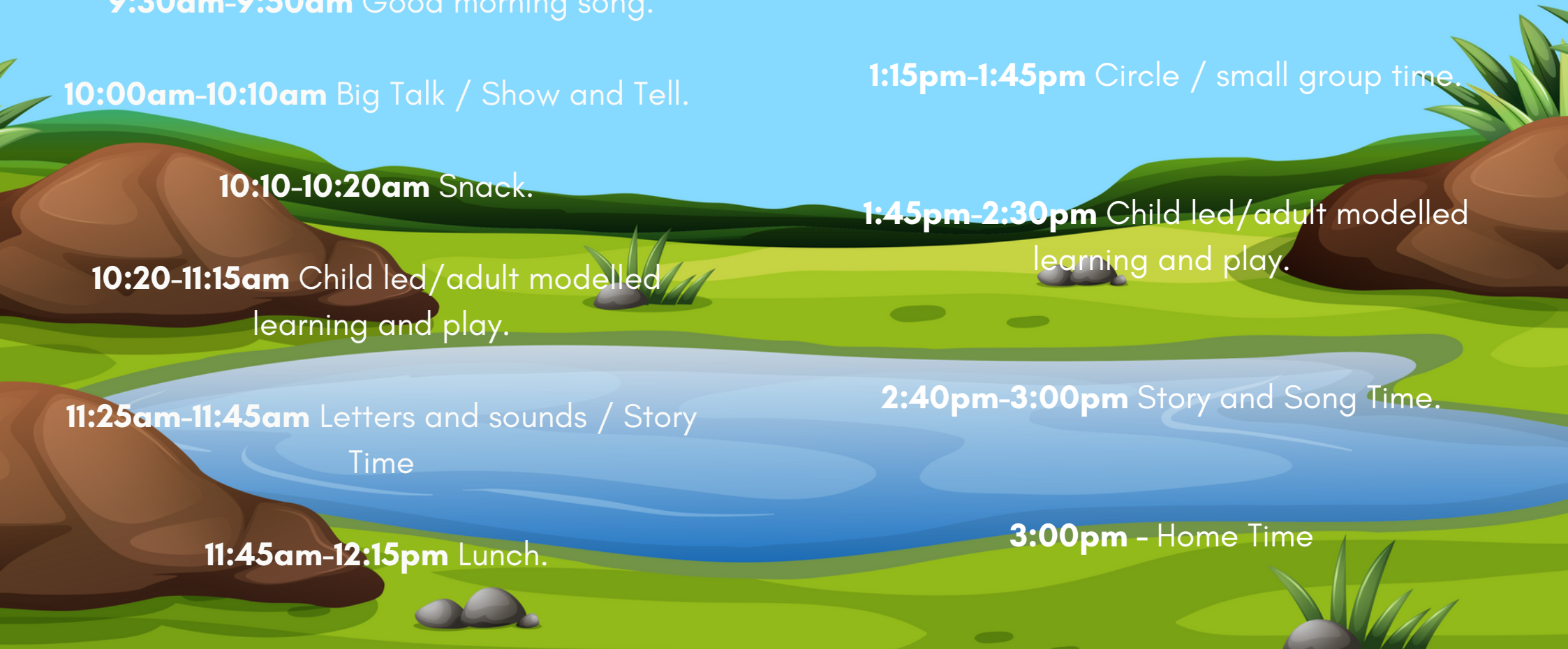
**12:45pm-1:15pm** Outdoor free play.
