British Values Democracy

When learning about Democracy we make decisions together.

We have a say in what happens through child initiated play, expressing our interests, choosing our stories and knowing our voice is listened to. We recognise that opinions are always important and encourage children to choose and make decisions, ensuring that every child should feel valued.

British Values Rule of Law

When learning about the rule of law we promote Freedom for all.

We make our own choices and have the freedom to express our likes and dislikes. We understand that our actions have rewards or consequences. This is supported by encouraging the children to follow our 5 class rules and discussing feelings rather than just asking a child to say sorry. We link the local community to our learning and invite the police and fireman into the provision to discuss rules and safety.

British Values Individual Liberty

When learning about individual Liberty we understand why rules are important.

We have a good understanding of the class rules and understand that rules are there to keep ourselves and others, safe, happy and secure. We provide opportunities for risk taking during physical development with obstacle courses etc. We value other children's opinions and self worth and build confidence by providing activities such as colour mixing etc.

British Values Mutual Respect

When learning about mutual respect we treat others how you want to be treated.

We work together to help one another and respect each other's wishes and we listen to others. We take on group roles, ensuring our classroom and resources are well respected, e.g. whole class tidy up, helping grown-ups with daily tasks. We always encourage the children to share stories and provide resources and activities that challenge gender, cultural and racial stereotyping.

British Values Tolerance

When learning about tolerance, we enjoy learning about different faiths and cultures.

We listen carefully to others points of view and investigate traditions, customs and religious practises through celebration of different festivals such as Chinese New Year, Burns Night, Diwali, Christmas, Easter, and our local festival 'Pirate Day'.
