We are very pleased with the figures in this report, with 99% of our families believing that their child is doing well and 100% telling us their child feel safe. 97% of parents believe their child to be happy. No one disagreed with “the school makes sure pupils are well behaved,” “the school has high expectations,” “my child does well at this school,” “there is a good range of subjects,” and “the school gives my SEN child the support to succeed.” In every area, agree responses were by far the most common response, mostly by 90% or more.

In addition, we had a number of parents write lovely comments about the school and staff. We also had suggestions for improvement. The main request was that we return to a weekly newsletter, that will start again for next week. I will be circulating comments and suggestions along with this survey to the staff for consideration and discussing the report with governors.
