The powerful knowledge we will take away from this Learning Enquiry (what will we be learning)

- Can talk about people who are familiar to them e.g., police, doctors, teachers etc.
- Talk confidently to adults and peers about their family and local community
- Talk about people that the children may have come across within their community, such as delivery and shop staff, hairdressers, the police, the fire service, nurses, doctors and teachers

Maths's focus:

Numbers to 10: focus on children's ability to recognise, represent and manipulate numbers to 10.

Comparing numbers within 10: focus on practising the skill of comparing groups of objects up to 10, using the key mathematical vocabulary of more, fewer, more than and less than.

Addition to 10: focus on adding two parts to make a whole up to 10, using a part-whole model to show two parts and the whole, in various orientations

Measure: focus on developing children's understanding of the different elements that can be measured

Literacy Focus:

The children will be taking part in a range of writing tasks, including writing about what they would like to be when they grow up and making a card for their hero.
