This chart explains our expectations for behaviour at our before and after school clubs.

Behaviour is monitored across a week and each new day starts fresh at green.

This behaviour chart is here to ensure enjoyable sessions for all participants.

ORANGE	<ul> <li>✓ Not listening to instructions</li> <li>✓ Damaging property</li> <li>✓ Disrupting sessions</li> <li>✓ Rudeness</li> <li>✓ Aggressive behaviour to others</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>A warning will be given to the child and a discussion about how to improve.</li> <li>If a second warning is given, the child's parents will be told at pick-up and Senior Leaders notified. Parents will be reminded that if behaviours across the week escalate, their attendance at the sessions are in jeopardy</li> </ul>
RED	<ul> <li>✓ Behaving in a way dangerous to others</li> <li>✓ Escalation of behaviour above</li> <li>✓ Defiance of a member of staff</li> <li>✓ Swearing</li> </ul>	❖ The child's place at before and/or after school club is in jeopardy, either permanently or for an agreed period of time. This is at the discretion of Senior Leaders and will be discussed with parents.
