### Maths's focus:

Addition: children will continue to explore addition, now looking specifically at the number bonds to 10

Subtraction: children will continue exploring subtraction, now looking specifically at the number bonds to 10.

Patterns: children will be encouraged to recognise, extend, create and explain simple repeating patterns

### Literacy Focus:

Storyboxes: The children will be creating their very own storyboxes and books to share with their parents.

The children will be extending their knowledge and comprehension skills through our story telling topic and consolidating their sentences writing skills.

### Home Learning Task:

Tell me a story: Over the last few weeks the children have been taking part in 'helicopter stories'. The children draw pictures to represent their story and then spend time with an adult sharing their tale. The class then act out the child's story. It is lots of fun. We would love for your child to draw their own story at home and tell you their tale.
