Step inside our learning...

This term, in Year 3 and 4, the children will be exploring what defines a hero. They will relate qualities of the school value heroes to their own personalities, as well as members of the local community. There will be a huge focus on our four British Values and how these contribute to us being more of a "hero." We will begin the Learning Experience with a superhero day, where the children will be turning themselves into their own creation of a school value. Throughout this learning experience, the children will also explore the artwork of Lichtenstein and produce high quality artwork inspired by his style. The artwork will be of local heroes that they nominate for an award at the ceremony the children will be hosting. Alongside this, the children will be writing speeches, inspired by our British Values, and letters about our local heroes. We will end the term with a very own Eden Park award ceremony, presenting awards to inspirational characters within our community.

Our Learning Values this half term are...

All of them! Throughout this learning experience, the children will be immersing themselves into each one of the learning values. We will identify who in our local community has attributes of Crystal Creativity, Isabelle Independence, Toby Teamwork and Roger Respect. Those individuals who the children feel display similarities to our learning values will be nominees for the awards ceremony. We will also focus on the British value democracy. The children will learn to think about the bigger picture. They will collectively as classes nominate those from the local community and consider how others actions affect more than just the person themselves.

Home Learning:
